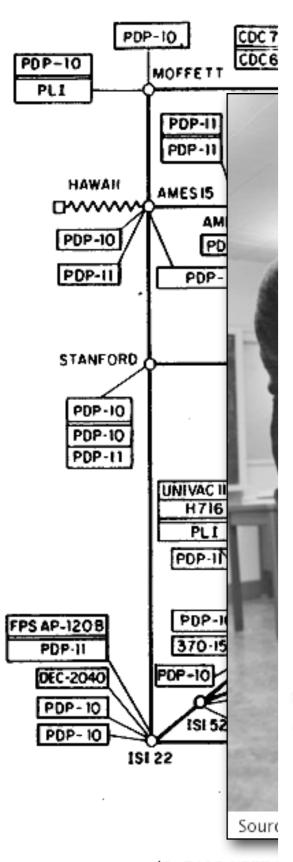

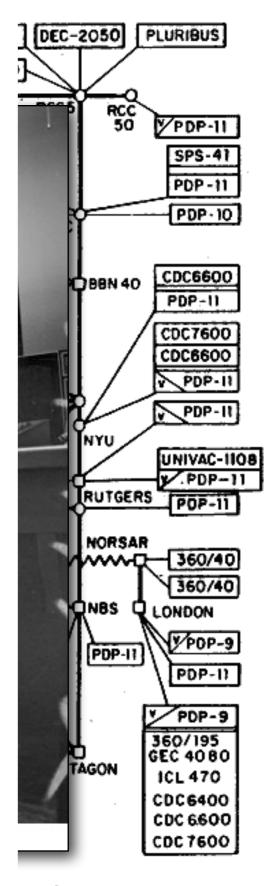

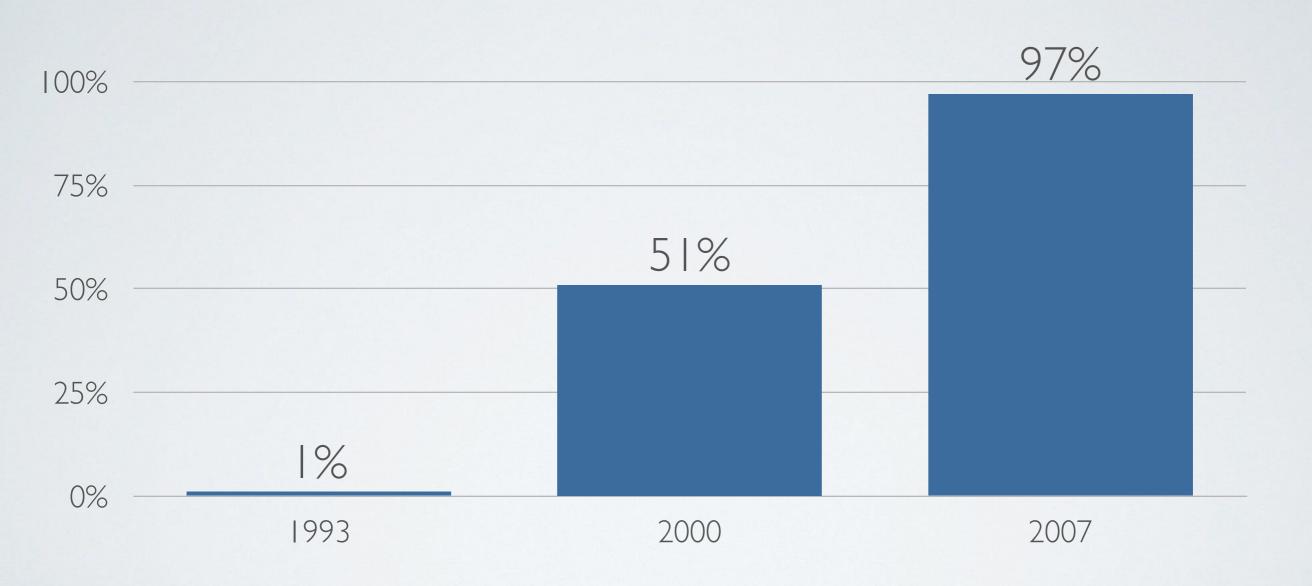

History of the Internet: Commercialization

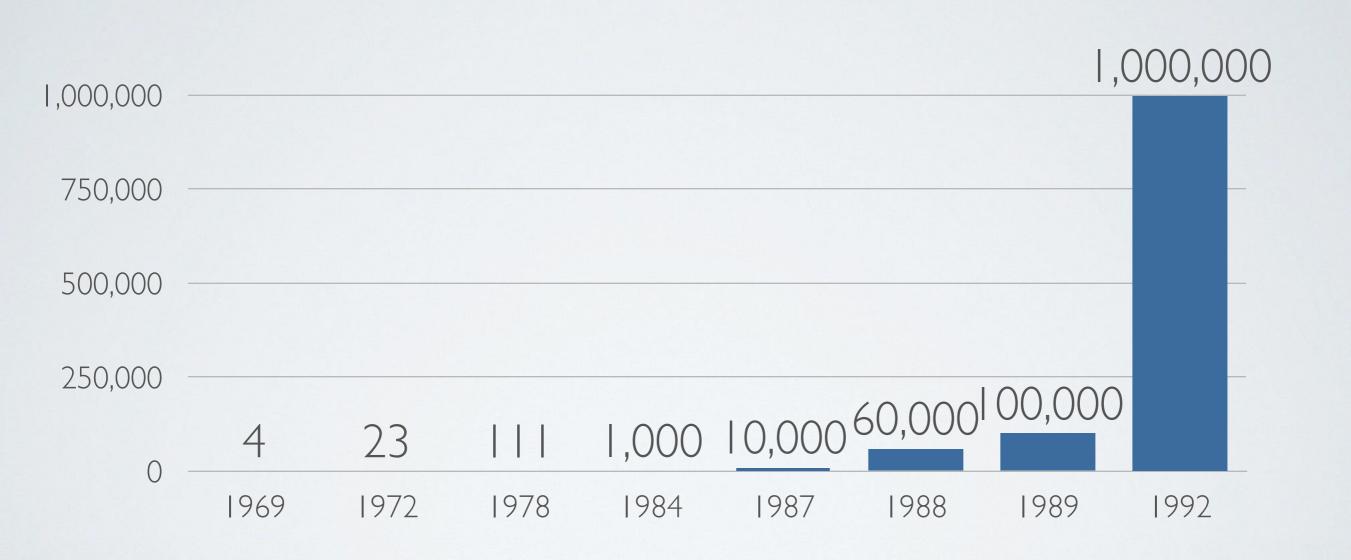
- 1990's: Emergence of Internet Service Providers (ISPs)
- 1995: Complete commercialization (no restriction to carry commercial traffic)
 - public e-mail (AOL)
 - instant messaging
 - VoIP (Voice over Internet Protocol) (e.g., Skype)
 - ****
 - online shopping, wikis, blogs, Facebook, Twitter

The percentage of two-way telecommunication carried on the Internet



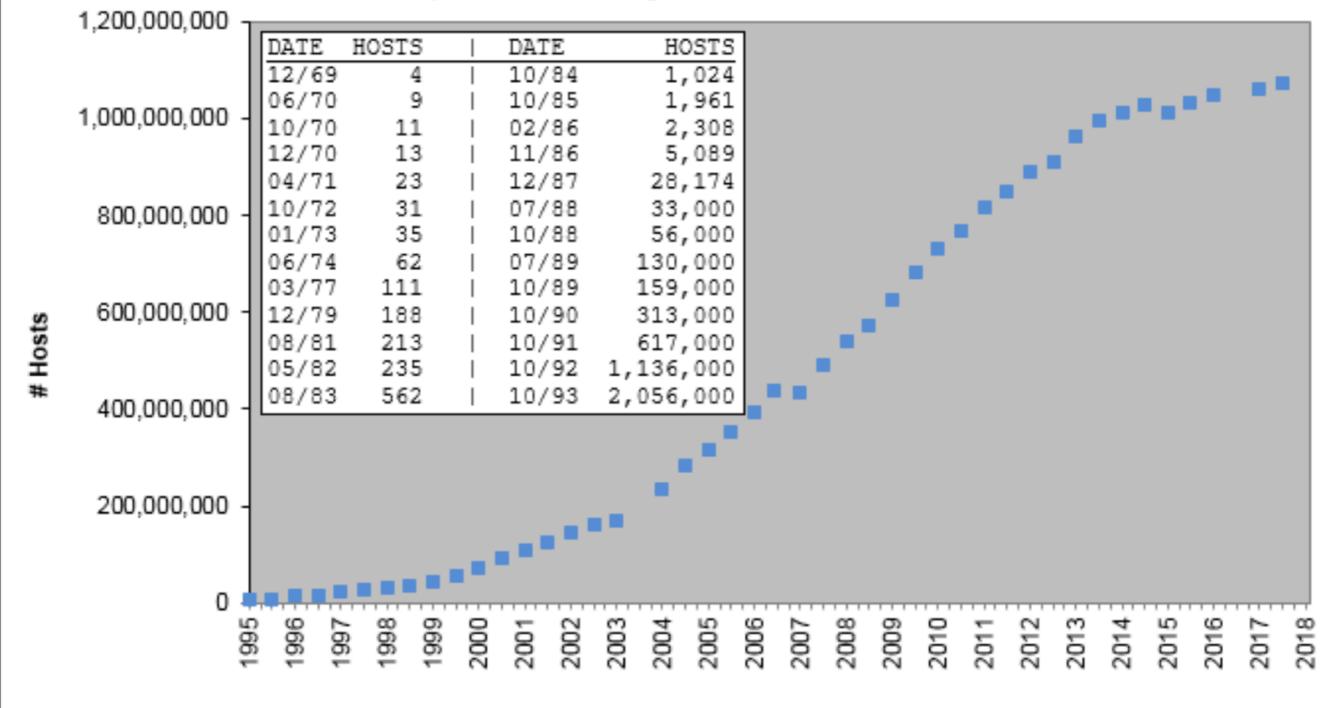

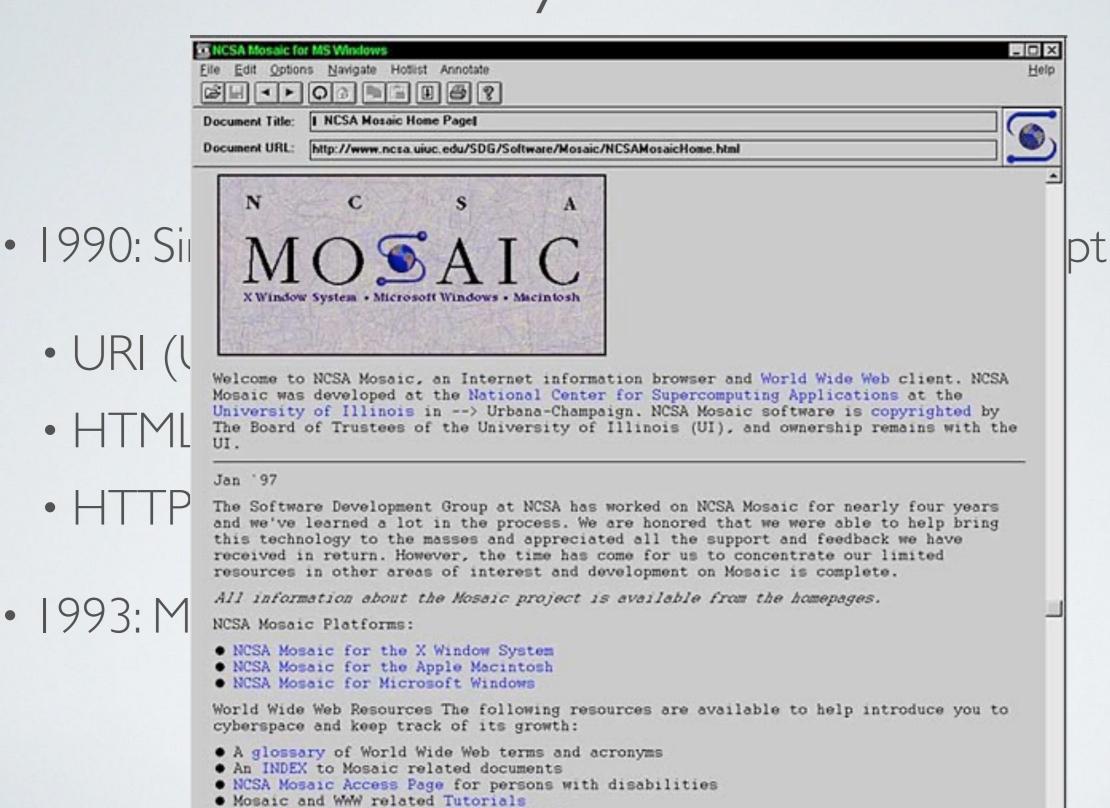

- 1990: Archie search engine
 - Developed at McGill to search FTP sites (~200 sites)
- 1991: WAIS (Wide Area Information Server)
- 1991: Gopher (search documents)
